AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in:

FIR No.	Dated	Police Station	Sections
276	17.11.2021	Maqboolpura, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar	379-B(2), 323, 34 IPC

2. The FIR was registered at the instance of Mahinderpal. It was alleged that on 17.11.2021, three persons stopped him at the back side of the flat in New Amritsar. One of the accused forcibly took out money from his trouser and inflicted injury on the little finger of the left hand with *Datar*. A reverse blow of *Datar* was given on the back and left leg.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 17.11.2021; Rs.350/- were recovered from the petitioner;

the recovery is not connected with the alleged incident. He further relies upon the fact that other co-accused were granted bail by the Sessions Court.

4. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for grant of bail, however, fairly submits that Rs.350/- cash was recovered from him and that co-accused were granted bail by Sessions Court.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, having conspectus of the facts and considering that though investigation is complete conclusion of trial is likely to take time and co-accused were granted bail by the Sessions Court, the petitioner is granted bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

6. The petition is allowed.
