Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.96 dated 19.7.2022 registered under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda.

On the last date of hearing, detailed order was passed and the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join the investigation. Today, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner apprised the Court that in compliance of the said order, the petitioner joined the investigation with the police.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Raghubir Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation and that only simple injuries are

attributed to the present petitioner.

However, the present petition is resisted by the counsel for the complainant.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation and only simple injuries are attributed to him, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 14.9.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
