AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 72 dated 18.6.2023, under Sections 3, 4,5 and 6 of Immoral Traffic Act, registered at Police Station Division No. 1, District Ludhiana.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner in order to avoid adverse order does not press the present petition. However, on instructions from his client, a request is made that the petitioner would surrender within two weeks from today and apply for regular bail, his application be taken up expeditiously.

The petition is dismissed as not pressed.

In case the petitioner surrenders within two weeks from today and applies for regular bail, the court concerned shall decide the same within three days.
