This is an application filed under Section 151 CPC for preponement of the date of hearing in the main case from 12.04.2023 to an early date.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the respondents have no objection in case the present application is allowed and the date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 12.04.2023 to today itself.

For the reasons stated in the application and with the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the present application is allowed and the

date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 12.04.2023 to today and the main case is taken on Board today itself for final disposal.

CM-575-CWP-2023

This is an application filed under Section 151 CPC for placing on record Annexures P-8 and P-9.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed.

Annexures P-8 and P-9 are taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

Main case

This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to correct the name of the petitioner from Ravindera Kumar to Ravindra Kumar in 12th Class Certificate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the name of the petitioner has been mentioned as Ravindra Kumar in Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-3). It is further submitted that the publication to the effect that name of the petitioner has been wrongly mentioned in his Intermediate Certificate of National Institute of Open Schooling in the year 2017 has been also done and for the said purpose, he has made reference to Annexure P-8. It is contended that even public notice in the Newspaper-Hindustan Times has been issued and the news cutting with respect to the same has been annexed as Annexure P-9.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has also submitted that since all the necessary documents are there on the record, thus, the present Civil

Writ Petition alongwith civil miscellaneous applications be treated as a representation of the petitioner by respondent Nos.1 and 2 and the decision on the same be taken within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the present order.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents has submitted that the respondents have no objection to the said course of action.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of with directions to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to treat the present Civil Writ Petition alongwith Annexures as representation by the petitioner and to consider and decide the same as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of four weeks from today, in accordance with law.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
