AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral)

In pursuance to the order passed by this Court on 18.04.2023, an affidavit of the Estate Officer, Greater Ludhiana Area Development Authority (GLADA), Ludhiana, has been filed in Court where in paras-2 and 3, It has been stated as follows:

“2. That draw of plots for allotment of 93 LIG, flats at Ludhiana, meant for riot affected persons could not held on 15.03.2019 due to the imposition of election code of conduct in Punjab w.e.f. 10.03.2019. Therefore, the draw of plots was postponed to 26.06.2019.

*3. That option of the petitioner was obtained which was given on 27.08.2018 to consider his name for allotment of a flat in LIG category. Therefore, the name of the petitioner was included in the draw of plots apart from 1472 applicants. However, petitioner has remained unsuccessful in the draw of plots. A copy of the list of draw of plots is attached as **Annexure R-3/2** to this affidavit.”*

In the light of the above, the petitioner having been unsuccessful in the draw of lot, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous. However, it is left open for the petitioner to put-forth his claim as and when the plots are advertised and a quota is fixed therein for allotment of flats/plots under the 1984 Sikh Riots Victims scheme.

Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
