The prayer in the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.19 dated 15.06.2023 under Sections 420 IPC (Sections 419, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC and Section 10 of the Immigration Act added later on) registered at Police Station Cyber Police, Rohtak.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a compromise had been arrived at between the parties as is evidence from the statement of the complainant (Annexure P-2). He, therefore, contends that as the petitioner was in custody since 08.07.2023, he may be granted the concession of bail.

3. The learned counsel for the complainant admits that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties and states that he has no objection if the petitioner is granted the concession of bail.

4. The learned counsel for the State, on the other hand, contends that serious allegations have been levelled against the petitioner for which he is not entitled to the concession as prayed for. He, however, admits that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

6. In view of the above, without going into the respective merits of the case, as a compromise has been arrived at between the parties, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner incarcerated.

7. Thus, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely, Jagdeep alias Rajan is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
