1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 438
Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in:-

FIR No.	Dated	Police Station	Sections
240	16.06.2023	Sadar, Narnaul, District Mahendergarh	420, 120-B IPC and Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 (Haryana Amendment Bill 2020) and Sections 192, 192-A and 196 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988

2. Upon instructions received from HC Deepak Kumar, State counsel submits that petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.
