1. Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. the petitioners seek issuance of directions to the State not to harass them.

2. At the outset, learned State counsel denies that the petitioners were ever called by the police and therefore they were never harassed. He further submits that at an earlier point of time a complaint was filed by one Jagtar Singh through which he had alleged that the petitioners have violated the provisions of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 Act and on investigation such complaint was found to be false and therefore filed.

3. In the light of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition at this stage.

4. Dismissed as not pressed.
