JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to settle his accounts and release payment arising out of processing of paddy for the crop year 2018-19.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has processed paddy of respondent for the crop year 2018-19. The petitioner after completing his job has filed his bills, however, respondent is not finalizing accounts and making payment. The petitioner has filed representation dated 13.09.2021 (Annexure P-2), however, respondent is not redressing grievance of the petitioner.

3. Mr. Somesh Gupta, Advocate who on advance notice is present in Court assures the Court that respondent would look into grievance of the petitioner and pass an appropriate order within 6 weeks

from today, however, he prays that petitioner may be directed to submit complete bills as well as requisite documents so that matter may be processed at the earliest.

4. In response, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner would submit bills as well as requisite documents within 2 weeks from today.

5. In the wake of statements of both sides, the petition stands disposed of.
