The petitioner seek the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.95 dated 10.05.2022 under Sections 21/29 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar Rural.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 14.09.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 14.09.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 14.09.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
