1. Case taken up at the mentioning of learned counsel for the petitioners.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of the present petition to enable the petitioners to approach the trial Court in view of the subsequent developments. It is submitted that the complainant, victim and eye witness while appearing as prosecution witnesses have not supported the version of the prosecution and were declared hostile as such.
3. Learned State counsel submits that the State has no objection to the limited prayer seeking withdrawal of the petition to avail of their remedy in accordance with law.
4. Accordingly, in view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
