The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.445 dated 15.08.2022 under Sections 147, 149, 323, 452, 506 IPC and Sections 25 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Jind Sadar, District Jind.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 15.09.2022 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Ravi Kundia, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jind-Detective in court today, which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioners have joined investigation in terms of orders dated 15.09.2022 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 15.09.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
