This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.64 dated 7.6.2021, registered at Police Station, Jhunir, District Mansa, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travels Professionals Regulation Act, 2014 on the basis of compromise between the parties.
