Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present petition, the petitioner claims the benefit of regularization from the date of his initial appointment, which benefit has already been granted to him by the respondents keeping in view the order dated 23.12.2016 (Annexure R-6) by which, the petitioner has been given the date of regular appointment as 29.07.2008, hence, the petitioner is also entitled for consequential benefits for the grant of ACP on completion of 8 and 18 years of service.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the petitioner could not be granted the benefit of ACP as there were disciplinary proceedings pending against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the disciplinary proceedings pending against the petitioner have attained finality, hence, now there is no impediment in the consideration of the claim of the petitioner for the grant of benefits under the ACP Scheme.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that keeping in view the fact that the disciplinary proceedings have already attained finality, the department will consider the claim of the petitioner for the grant of ACP as per the entitlement of the petitioner keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and appropriate order on the said consideration will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order and in case, as per the speaking order, the petitioner becomes entitled for any benefit, the same will also be released to him within a further period of four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
