VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.4 to submit his enquiry report to respondent No.2 and further respondent No.2 be directed to take appropriate steps on the enquiry report within a specified time frame.

2. Learned State Counsel has submitted, on instructions from Ranjodh Singh, Village Development Officer, Block Rayya, District Amritsar, that in the present case, the authorities had issued a suspension notice/order dated 30.03.2012 to respondent No.5 and against the same, respondent No.5 had filed an appeal and the Director had set aside the said

order and remanded the matter to the BDPO and the BDPO is ceased of the matter and the BDPO would finish the said proceedings within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order. It is further submitted that in view of the same, the present Civil Writ Petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed that the present writ petition be disposed of in view of the above but has further prayed that the State be directed to conclude the proceedings before the BDPO in a time bound manner.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of with a direction to the BDPO to conclude the proceedings before the said authority within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.
