Prayer in this case filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.164 dated 15.06.2023 registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station GRP, Ambala Cantt.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that as per the prosecution allegations, 8 grams of heroin was recovered from the possession of petitioner, which is much below the commercial category. Petitioner is in custody since 15.06.2023. Prayer has been made for grant of regular bail.

Notice of motion.

Mr. P.K. Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State.

Learned State Counsel does not dispute the fact that recovered quantity falls much below the commercial category. However, learned State Counsel submits that the petitioner is also facing trial in three other cases in different states though details of those cases are not revealed.

Custody certificate placed on record by learned State Counsel shows

that the applicant- petitioner is in custody for last 02 months and 13 days.

Having noticed the afore-said facts but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
