Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.366 dated 17.7.2022 registered under Sections 22C, 27A of NDPS Act at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

On the last date of hearing, detailed order was passed and the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join the investigation with the observation that only allegations against the petitioner are that main accused Madan Lal procured 250 tablets of Tramadol covered under non-commercial quantity from co-accused Surinder who further purchased the same from present petitioner-Atma Ram.

Counsel for the petitioner informed the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of the aforesaid order of interim bail.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Roshan Lal has not

disputed the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further apprised the Court that the petitioner, who is having no criminal history, is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 11.11.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
