The prayer in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No.80 dated 05.07.2019 under Sections 363 and 366-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.8, Police Commissionerate Jalandhar, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Even on the last date of hearing, learned State counsel has apprised this Court of the fact that the vide order dated 23.04.2022, the petitioner has been acquitted and therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.

On the last date of hearing, none had appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Even today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has again reiterated that present petition has become infructuous in view of the fact that the petitioner has been acquitted.
