Present writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for setting aside the order dated 13.07.2023 (Annexure P-15) passed by respondent No.3-Deputy Commissioner, Sonipat vide which respondent No.3 held that educational certificate of 10th standard taken by respondent No.6 is genuine and as such complaint given against her is unfound and baseless. Further prayer has been made for directing the respondents not to allow respondent No.6 to work as Sarpanch since she is ineligible as per the provision of Section 175(v) of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 and for directing the Election Tribunal to decide the election petition dated 09.12.2022 (Annexure P-6) filed by the petitioner against respondent No.6 within stipulated period preferably within six months.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly submitted before this Court that he does not press the present petition as

election petition is already pending adjudication. He submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition by directing the Competent Authority to decide the election petition within six months.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Upasna Dhawan, AAG, Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4-State.

In view of the above position, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed. Learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Gannaur is directed to hear the election petition dated 09.12.2022 (Annexure P-6) and decide the same in accordance with law, within a period of six months from today.
