The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for the grant of anticipatory bail in case registered vide FIR No.79 dated 28.07.2023 under Sections 22(c) of the NDPS Act and Section 29 of the NDPS Act (added later on) registered at P.S. Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 18.08.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Lakhwinder Singh, DSP, Rural, District Gurdaspur in Court today, which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 18.08.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 18.08.2023 is

made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
