AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. The present petition has been filed seeking extension of time granted to the petitioner to visit abroad vide order dated 14th December, 2022 in FIR No. RC0512015S0009, dated 5th October, 2015, under Sections 120B read with Section 498A of IPC, 1860 and Sections 3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961, registered at Police Station SCB, CBI, Chandigarh.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner realising that petitioner has not approached the Court concerned for extending the time period granted for going abroad, is not pressing the petition at this stage. However, he submits that condition was imposed in the order dated 14th December, 2022 that appellant shall not seek any further extension.

3. The petition is dismissed as not pressed with liberty to approach the Court concerned for extension of time.

4. There is no doubt that in eventuality of the petitioner

making an application for extension of time before the Court concerned for the extension of time, the same would be considered in accordance with law.

5. Since the main case has been dismissed as not pressed pending application if any is rendered infructuous.
