The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.161 dated 06.07.2022 registered under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Daljit Singh, submits that in pursuance of order dated 15.09.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 15.09.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
