This petition has been filed seeking a writ of *Certiorari* quashing the Impugned speaking order dated 16.06.2023 (Annexures P-6), whereby the petitioner's request for transfer/adjustment near the place of his residence has been rejected.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is serving as a guest faculty P.G.T. (English) at Government Senior Secondary Bhana Brahmanan (School code 1516) Jind. His ailing mother, aged 86 years, resides at his place of residence in Julana, Jind. Therefore, to take care of her, the petitioner should be adjusted somewhere around Julana.

3. Learned State counsel, appearing on advance notice, submits that considering the petitioner's request sympathetically, he has already been adjusted in the District of his choice at Narwana. Still dissatisfied, he approached this Court again seeking adjustment near place of his residence. His request has

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between his place of residence and his present place of posting is about ninety kilometers only.

4. Heard.

5. It is apparent on record that the petitioner has already been adjusted/posted near his place of residence by considering his request sympathetically. An ailing mother does not entitle him to seek a writ of *mandamus* for transfer near the place of residence. There is no provision in the policy either on the basis of which he can seek transfer/adjustment to take care of an ailing family member. Therefore, no ground is made out to entertain the petition.

6. Dismissed.
