Prayer made in the present writ petition is for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to consider and take a final decision on the application submitted by the petitioner for grant of death benefit of the deceased Advocate who was husband of the petitioner and for disbursement of such benefit out of the funds created for the said purpose.

Mr. C.M. Munjal, Advocate alongwith Ms. Seema, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondent No.3-Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and has pointed out that the requisite benefits as per the admissible policy have already been released in favour the petitioner and that the present writ petition has been rendered

infructuous.

Counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same and accepts that the payment has already been transferred in the account of the petitioner.

The present writ petition has been disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is however, granted to the petitioner to pursue his alternative remedies for seeking enhancement of the compensation, if any, as per law.
