1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect their lives and liberty, as they apprehend threat at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

2. Learned State counsel submits that an enquiry has been marked to Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dinanagar. During the course of enquiry, it was found that the petitioners came back to their house and got recorded their statements before ASI Gurdev Singh of Police Post Bariar and they stated that they did not apprehend any danger from any person and did not require any security. Learned State counsel further submits that in case any complaint is received with regard to the threat to the lives and liberty of the petitioners, appropriate action shall be taken in accordance with law.

3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further

directions are required in the matter and the petition is accordingly disposed off.
