Prayer in the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for extension of parole granted to the petitioner w.e.f. 25.07.2023 to 23.08.2023 under the provisions of The Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 2022, for two months due to the surgery recommended for the petitioner's wife.

2. When confronted with the provisions of sub-Section 5 of Section 11 of The Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 2022, (hereinafter referred to the Act, 2022) which provides that no parole or furlough shall be extended in any case, learned counsel for the petitioner requested for permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file a representation before the competent authority for grant of emergency parole under Section 5 of the Act, 2022, on account of the petitioner's wife having

to undergo surgery as recommended by Balaji Hospital and Trauma Centre, vide Annexure P/2 dated 11.08.2023.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Surender Pannu, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, in view of the position noted above, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.

6. In case any application for emergency parole is submitted by the petitioner under Section 5 of the Act, 2022, *ibid*, to the competent authority, the same be considered and decided within period of time specified in respect thereto in accordance with law.

7. Petition disposed of with the aforementioned directions.
