Status report by way of affidavit of Shri Rajender Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dabwali, District Sirsa has been filed on behalf of the respondent- State, along with custody certificate.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner has made a statement so as to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach this Court after the statement of the complainant – Mukesh Kumar is recorded during trial. He has further requested to direct the trial Court to record statement of main witness Mukesh at the earliest.
