Although four separate writ petitions have been filed by the petitioner claiming various reliefs, but counsel for the petitioner(s) has made a reference to the written statement filed on behalf of official respondents No.1 to 3 in CWP-21772-2021, wherein it has been submitted as under:-

“6. That one post of Medical Superintendent is lying vacant in Shri Krishna AYUSH University, Kurukshetra. The present petitioner is the senior most Associate Professor (Shalya Tantra) in the Shri Krishna Government Ayurvedic College, Kurukshetra and subject to petitioner's satisfaction in lieu of the prayer made in the present petition, the petitioner can be accommodated on the post of Medical Superintendent in the Answering Respondent University.”

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied with the offer made by the respondents before this Court, provided necessary order is passed in a time bound manner.

In view of the above, writ petitions are disposed of with a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to pass appropriate order in view of the above reproduced stand, within a period of six weeks from today.
