Present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking anticipatory bail in a case bearing FIR No.0097 dated 14.03.2022 under Sections 420/406 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Urban Estate, District, Hisar (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although as per order dated 02.12.2022; passed by this Court, the petitioner was to deposit a sum of Rs.2 lakh with the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, however, the matter has been settled between the parties to the satisfaction of the complainant and the entire disputed amount has been paid to the complainant.

Learned counsel for the complainant does not dispute the above said factual position as stated above.

Vide order dated 02.12.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that pursuant to order dated 02.12.2022, petitioner has joined the

investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ramphal has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 11.01.2023 and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 02.12.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed off.
