AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

In the backdrop of settlement between the parties, the Insurance Company has not opposed the condonation of delay of 155 days in filing the present appeal at any juncture and as such, in view of the settlement that has been arrived between the parties, the delay in filing the appeal is condoned.

Vide order dated 28.03.2023, on the basis of the statement made by learned counsel for the appellant, a proposal was made for enhancing compensation by Rs.1,25,000/- over and above the amount already granted by the MACT concerned. Today, learned counsel for the Insurance Company has stated that the Insurance Company has agreed to enhance the compensation only by Rs.85,000/- and not by Rs. 1,25,000/- and has signed to that effect. Learned counsel for the appellant has agreed to this counter offer of the respondent-Insurance Company.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.85,000/- (Rupees Eighty Five Thousand only) favouring appellant-Sahi Ram son of Sh. Devi Ram with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 02.10.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque from the office

signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
