Petitioners have approached this Court praying for issuance of direction to the respondents to fix the Survey Stones (Pillars/Birjiyat) in village Kunda Kalan, Tehsil and District Karnal as per the report dated 10.11.2020 (Annexure P-7) and further to take action on the application dated 06.01.2021 (Annexure P-8) within some specified time.

Mr. Amit Kalia, Patwari is present in person in Court. He has submitted that survey stones (pillars/birjiyat) have been fixed with the help of team of Survey of India.

Learned State counsel has submitted that as the grievance of the petitioners has been redressed, nothing survives in the present petition. He submits that in all 21 bhurjis were to be fixed out of which 17 bhurjis have already been fixed and remaining could not be fixed to enable the farmers to take their trolleys loaded with sugar canes. He submits that remaining 4 bhurjis would also be fixed after harvesting the crop of sugar canes.

However, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the bhurjis have not been fixed at earmarked places and for the same, the petitioners have already filed objections before the Deputy Commissioner.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner to deal with the objections filed by the petitioners and decide the same expeditiously in accordance with law.
