1. This is a petition seeking quashing of orders dated 25.3.2023 and 27.7.2022 passed in complaint bearing CIS No. COMA/05/2019 CNR No. HRGR01-007022-2019 dated 18.5.2019 wherein the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed person and proceedings under Section 174-A IPC has been initiated.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner on instruction restricts his prayer to the extent that petitioner would surrender before the Court concerned within ten days from today and shall apply for regular bail, the same be directed to be decided expeditiously.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent has no objection to the restricted prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. The petition is disposed of. In eventuality of petitioner surrendering before the trial Court within ten days from today and applying for regular bail, his application shall be decided by the Court concerned on the same day.

5. Since the main case has been disposed of the pending application(s), if any is rendered infructuous.
