The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.79 dated 16.08.2022 under Sections 323, 324, 326 and 34 IPC at Police Station Fattu DHINGA, Tehsil and District Kapurthala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 15.09.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

A status report dated 09.01.2023 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhchain Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 15.09.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 15.09.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
