The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for the grant of anticipatory bail in case registered vide FIR No.0064 dated 24.07.2023 under Sections 307, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 & 27 of Arms Act registered at P.S. Sadar, Rupnagar.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 18.08.2023 passed by this Court, petitioners has joined the investigation.

The Counsel for the complainant has vehemently opposed the grant of anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

The learned State Counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Tarlochan Singh, DSP, District Rupnagar in Court today, which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioner has

joined investigation in terms of orders dated 18.08.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 18.08.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
