Present writ petition has been filed for setting aside the order/direction dated 10.12.2015 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.3, to the Revenue Officials for cancellation of allotment/sale deed executed in favour of the petitioners in accordance with the provisions of Punjab Package Deal Properties (Disposal) Act, 1976 and rules framed thereunder. Further prayer has been made to set aside the order dated 10.12.2015 in light of the order dated 07.12.2016 (Annexure P-8) passed by this Court setting aside similar orders and further to direct the respondent authorities to follow law as prescribed in Section 7 of the Punjab Package Deal properties (Disposal) Act, 1976 and not to take any action against the petitioners without granting proper and adequate opportunity of hearing in light of the Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that allotment of the land, which was earlier cancelled, has been restored, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of as infructuous.
