1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of memorandum dated 16.12.2022 whereby an inquiry has been initiated against the petitioner.
2. Mr. S.K. Sharma, Senior Panel Counsel who on advance notice is present in Court, at the outset, submits that petitioner being civilian in the Airforce has remedy to file petition before Central Administrative Tribunal.
3. The petitioner is unable to controvert the said fact except that he is unable to engage counsel.
4. The petition stands dismissed with liberty to petitioner to approach Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh.
5. The Legal Services Authority of this Court is directed to provide a counsel to the petitioner to approach CAT, if he needs.
