Prayer in this petition is for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 in FIR No. 0345 dated 09.09.2019, registered under Sections 420 and 506 of the IPC (including other sections added later on) at Police Station Civil Lines, Jind, District Jind, vide order dated 10.08.2020 passed by this Court in CRM-M-13439-2020.

As per office report, respondent No. 2 has died and respondent No. 3 was served through SHO of the Police Station concerned, however, learned counsel for the petitioner/complainant submits that the talks of compromise are going on between the parties.

Even otherwise, a period of about three years has lapsed; challan has been presented; charges have been framed and in the entire petition, there is no averment that respondent No. 3, after being granted concession of anticipatory bail by this Court, has ever misused the same or

has tried to influence the prosecution witnesses, as it is specifically submitted by the DSP (Law & Order), Jind that the investigation is complete and charges have been framed.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to recall the order dated 10.08.2020.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
