The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for the issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to take action as per law on the representation dated 04.05.2022 by the petitioner.

On 16.09.2022, the following order was passed:-

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to take action as per Law and to decide the representation/complaint dated 04.05.2022 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner to respondent No.3.

As per the averments made in the present petition respondent Nos. 3 to 5 have encroached some private passage by constructing hut therein after cutting 03 trees. As per allegations made in the present petition it appears that respondent Nos. 3 to 5 are migrant labourers.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 at this stage.

In the meanwhile, direction is issued to Deputy Commissioner Jalandhar, Punjab to look into the matter and to verify the ownership of the petitioner as well as respondent Nos. 3 to 5 with regard to the site in dispute and then to submit his report in this regard within a period of next 08 weeks.

Now be listed on 06.12.2022.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

The learned State counsel while referring to the reply dated 29.11.2022 submits that the respondent Nos.3 to 5 are migrant labour who have not encroached upon any passage but have only constructed a temporary hut.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
