LISA GILL, J.

This appeal has been filed by the appellant-husband challenging judgment dated 19.07.2019, passed by learned Principal District Judge, Family Court, Bhiwani, whereby petition under Section 13(1)(ia)(ib) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, filed by him, has been dismissed.

Notice of motion was issued in this appeal on 02.09.2019, subject to payment of ₹25,000/- as litigation expenses to the respondent. Various opportunities were afforded to the appellant to deposit the litigation expenses. Following order was passed on 13.01.2023:-

“Learned counsel for the appellant submits that litigation expenses in terms of order dated 02.09.2019 shall be deposited within one week with the Registry of this Court.

At request, adjourned to 29.03.2023.

In case, needful is not done as stated before us, this appeal may be dismissed for non-prosecution.”

Learned counsel for the appellant informs that needful has still not been done despite the appellant being apprised of the earlier orders and necessary consequences.

It appears that the appellant is not interested in pursuing the matter any longer. Accordingly, present appeal is dismissed for non-prosecution.
