This is a civil writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents no.1 to 4 to take necessary action against the private respondents and to remove them from the post of Member Panchayat.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sukhjinder Singh, BDPO, has submitted that the private respondents no.5 to 8 have been suspended and the gram panchayat is working under the Sarpanch and the remaining panches and no administor has been appointed, and has submitted that thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said fact.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the same or to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives.
