In compliance of order dated 25.05.2022, status report dated 02.06.2022 has been received from Trial Court.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Paramjit Singh submits that in the instant case FIR, evidence of prosecution was concluded on 05.01.2023 and now the trial is fixed for 17.01.2023 for recording statement of accused as envisaged under Section 313 Cr.P.C. He further submits that earnest and sincere efforts shall be made at the instance of Prosecuting Agency for the conclusion of trial.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the trial has reached at its fag end, Trial Court may be asked to expedite the trial and conclude the same at the earliest and, thus, prays for withdrawal of this petition.

Since, trial of instant case FIR has reached at its fag end, Trial Court is directed to make earnest and sincere efforts to conclude the trial at the earliest.

In view of above, instant petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
