1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a case bearing FIR No.150 dated 18.02.2019 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Nuh.

2. Vide order dated 16.09.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 16.09.2022, petitioners have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from Investigating Officer, has affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation in the present case is not required, however, they may be directed to remain present as and when required by the Investigating

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Officer in the present case.

4. In view of the above, interim order dated 16.09.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C and the petitioners shall remain present as and when required by the Investigating Officer in the present case.
5. The present petition stands disposed of.
