Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to pay the excess amount of compensation in view of the decision dated 25.11.2019 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel on instructions from the petitioners submits that they have taken recourse to the remedy of execution before learned Additional District Judge, Jalandhar and the amount of compensation has already been deposited by the concerned quarter with the executing Court.
