JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J.

The prayer in the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for the grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No.221 dated 21.10.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420, 201, 120-B IPC at Police Station Kotwali Patiala.

2. As per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner and his mother Suman Aggarwal had received a sum of Rs.25 lakhs as a sale consideration for sale of a shop and a house. Later on, it transpired that the agreements on the basis of which the petitioner was intending to sell the properties to the complainants were forged.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that during the course of this proceedings, a compromise has been arrived at between the

parties in furtherance of which he has handed over three drafts totalling Rs.20,75,000/- to the complainants who are present in Court.

4. On the other hand, the learned counsel for the State does not dispute the factum of a compromise having been arrived at between the parties.

5. Mr. Vivek Thakur, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant. He has accepted the factum of the compromise and has stated that he has no objection if the petitioner is granted the concession of regular bail.

6. In view of the above, as the petitioner is in custody since 05.06.2023, his further incarceration is not required.

7. Thus without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner-Divanshu Aggarwal son of Yuvraj Aggarwal is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

8. The petition stands disposed of.
