This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing all red entries vide Rapat No.266 dated 08.03.2017 entered in (Annexure P-1) dated 15.11.2016 in the revenue record of petitioner No.1 in jamabandi pertaining to year 2011-12 of Village Malaud Rorhiyav, Tehsil Malaud, District Ludhiana and in the revenue record of petitioner No.2 entered vide Rapat No.132 dated 26.12.2016 entered in (Annexure P-2) dated 24.03.2017 in the revenue record in jamabandi pertaining to year 2014-15 of Village Nagoka, Tehsil Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

Learned State counsel, who appeared on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 7, on instructions from Mr. Preet Bhupinder Singh, Excise Officer, Sangrur, has submitted that the present Civil Writ Petition has been

rendered infructuous inasmuch as the red entries have been ordered to be released and recovery has already been effected from respondent No.8. He has handed over a copy of letters dated 06.03.2019 and 13.03.2019 which are taken on record as Mark 'A' and 'B'.

On 23.05.2019, none had appeared on behalf of the petitioners. Even on 25.08.2022, the position remained the same and the following order was passed:-

Learned counsel for respondent No.8 submits that he has instructions to state that the order of attachment has since been withdrawn and thus, the writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
