On 29.10.2022, the petitioner was directed to arraign the aggrieved persons as private respondents by filing appropriate application withing four weeks. The said order was not complied with that on 19.12.2022.

On 19.12.2022, following order was passed:-

“Counsel for the petitioner seeks time to comply with the order dated 29.11.2022.

List on 27.1.2023.

It is clarified that in case the order dated 29.11.2022 is not complied with before the next date, this Court shall treat this petition as defective and shall dismiss the same for non-prosecution.”

It appears that in the order dated 19.12.2022, the date 29.11.2022 has been wrongly mentioned instead of 29.10.2022.

Despite the aforesaid clear order, the petitioner has not complied with the order dated 29.10.2022 till date.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances, dismissed in default for want of compliance.
