1. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the prayer in the present petition is to release the service benefit to the petitioner in respect of the service rendered by her mother, namely, Smt. Kamla Devi, who unfortunately, died while in service on 07.03.2022. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that further prayer of the petitioner is to consider her for the compassionate appointment. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that prayer for compassionate appointment may kindly be treated as having been not pressed.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Devi Dutt, Superintendent, O/o Irrigation Department, Haryana, submits that all the service benefits for which the petitioner is entitled for in respect of the service rendered by her late mother, Kamla Devi, has already been released to her and in case, the petitioner feels that any of the benefit has not been released to her, she can approach the authorities by filing appropriate representation.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file a representation in case, any of the relief for which the petitioner is entitled for, has not been released so far.
