The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.685 dated 13.07.2019 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Chandnibagh, District Panipat.
