The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in cross-case bearing DDR No.12 dated 28.11.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 379, 148 and 149 IPC, (Section 326 of IPC was added later on) in case FIR No.154 dated 27.11.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 379, 148 and 149 IPC (Sections 325 and 326 of IPC was added later) on at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab.

A short reply dated 03.10.2023 by way of an affidavit of Talwinder Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Rural, District Hoshiarpur has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.09.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.
