AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

On the last date of hearing following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the appellants states that, if an amount of Rs.14,25,000/- is paid, over and above the amount already awarded by learned MACT, this appeal can be settled. Counsel for the claimants has signed the proposal form.

To us, this offer seems to be just, reasonable and equitable in the facts and circumstances of the case. Learned counsel for the respondent-Insurance Company prays for time to get concurrence from the concerned authority.

To come up on 09.03.2023.

Copy of the order be supplied to the representative/counsel of the respondent-Insurance Company.”

Mr. Vikram Singh, Advocate for the appellants was present. He signed the consent agreement, showing willingness to accept an amount of Rs.14,25,000/- (Rupees Fourteen Lakhs Twenty Five Thousand Only) towards full and final settlement of the claim in the present appeal.

The learned counsels as well as the officers of the respondent No.4-

Insurance Company has also signed the said statement today accepting the proposal made by the counsel for the appellants.

As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount will be paid to the appellants as per MACT award.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit crossed cheques in the sum of Rs.14,25,000/- (Rupees Fourteen Lakhs Twenty Five Thousand Only) in the respective names of all the appellants in the same proportion as awarded by MACT with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 04.05.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
